CHANGE TO KS2 SCHOOL UNIFORM

Dear Parents,

Following discussions with staff, pupils, governors and parents, we have now decided to go ahead with a change of our school uniform in September 2016.

From September, all KS2 children will be expected to wear a collared white shirt (short or long sleeved) with a school (clip-on) tie. We will be changing to V-neck sweatshirts and continuing with girl's cardigans, which are available from our school office to purchase. V-neck sweatshirts will be available after half term, although orders can be made now via the school office in the usual way.

KS1 and Early Years will continue to wear white polo shirts with schools round neck sweatshirts or school cardigans as we feel that ties would not be appropriate for our younger children.

In order to help parent's with this transition, school will purchase every KS2 child's first tie for them and will distribute them on the first day of the autumn term. Therefore, children should come to school on the first day with their white collared shirt on. If children lose their ties, they will be expected to replace them at a cost of £3.00. These will be available to buy at the school office.

We would prefer that all children wear V-necks from September but realise this may not be possible for some parents. Therefore, we felt that it was appropriate for round neck sweatshirts to be allowed during the transition year 2016-17 (with a shirt and tie), giving parents time to purchase V-necks ready for September 2017 when we expect all KS2 pupils to be in V-neck sweatshirts or cardigans.

There are a number of children who wear non-school sweatshirts or cardigans at the moment and we request that from September all children wear our school sweatshirts.

Thank you in advance for your support in improving our school uniform.
