Dear Parents,

As you are now aware due to your role as a Key Worker, your child(ren) will have a place here at school through these difficult times- either every day or as and when you need us. In order to help things run as smoothly as possible, here are our answers to your probable questions:

### **How will the children be organised?**

We will be splitting the children into two groups. Group 1- Reception and KS1 and Group 2- KS2.

### **Who will supervise the children?**

In the mornings, the staff have been placed on a rota and each group will have teacher and a member of support staff with them. The children will spend the morning completing the tasks set for that day by their teachers on the website.

Therefore, if they have been given a pack with an exercise book, this needs to come to school with them every day.

In the afternoons, Premier Sport will be supervising the children and will be running this like a holiday club. They may be outside for some of the time so should wear trainers if possible.

### **What should my child wear?**

Children will not be expected to come in school uniform but must bring a warm coat with them for outdoor sessions and wear something they can exercise in during the afternoons.

### **What will they have for lunch?**

All Reception and Key Stage One children will receive a meal from the kitchen as usual, although they can bring their own lunch if you prefer. Children who are entitled to Free School Meals in Key Stage Two will also be provided with a meal. However, the other children in Key Stage Two should bring a packed lunch as the kitchen will only be manned by one cook- our other kitchen staff have been moved to other roles within the company. I would ask that you stick to our normal expectations of no sweets, chocolate or fizzy drinks.

### **Where should children go in the mornings?**

Key Stage Two children will be taught in the first mobile classrooms (34M/5B classroom) and should go to the KS2 playground ready for 8:50am. Reception and Key Stage One children will all be taught in the Early Years department and should wait by the side gate ready for it to be unlocked at 8:50am. School will finish at 3:15pm for all children.

### **If I do not wish my child to attend on some days for reasons such as illness or I am not working what should I do?**

Your child is now placed on our register and this will be taken daily. We ask that any day that your child will not be attending for any reasons, please text or email us before 8:30 on the day, and each absent day, to let us know and therefore not to expect them in school- we won't worry about them if we have a text!

### **Will Chadley's before and after school club be running?**

Yes, Chadley's will be running as usual and you can contact Adam directly on 07984241685 to book places.
