



## Pupil Voice Meeting - House Captains

Friday 29<sup>th</sup> March 2019

<b>1</b>	Present	Chair: Mr Dobberson (Assistant Head); Mrs Hunt (Governor); Aafreen, Callum, Alfie, Mckayla, Chloe, Nathan, Gabriella, Oliver (House Captains)
<b>2</b>	Prayer	Read.
<b>3</b>	Duties	The house captains reported back on their duties, and expressed that there were no issues or concerns. Mr Dobberson reminded them of the system for collecting house points, and also thanked them for carrying out their tasks effectively and independently.
<b>4</b>	House Competition	<p>After a brief discussion, it was agreed that this half-term's house competition would be an orienteering-style photo trail. Further discussion focused on how to differentiate this, so that KS1 would be able to take part.</p> <p>Although Mr Dobberson would need to finalise arrangements, it was agreed that KS1's photo trail would only cover a more limited area of the school – possibly just the KS1 playground – and that the photos used would be larger and more obvious.</p> <p>The KS2 photo trail would cover a greater area, and there would be more challenging photos to locate.</p> <p>The photo trails would be completed in classes (rather than year groups). KS2 teachers would run the photo trails themselves, but the KS1 competitions would be run by the house captains.</p> <p>Mr Dobberson would sort out the photos and maps for the competitions, and would train in house captains in how to run them. He would also put a timetable together (with classes taking part on either Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> April or Friday 5<sup>th</sup> April), and let staff know the rules.</p>
<b>5</b>	Summer Fayre	Although still some way off, ideas for stalls at the Summer Fayre were put forward and discussed. Plenty of interesting ideas were put forward, and Mr Dobberson said that he's suggested these to Mrs Kirkham (PFA).
<b>6</b>	Health & Safety	No health and safety issues arose.
