

ART: We will be looking at the artist Barbara Garrison to see how she used printing. We will then make our own printing plate using recycled materials to print a scene from our planet.

D&T: We will be learning how to complete a running stitch using a needle and thread with the theme of saving our planet. Using an old t-shirt we will be tie dying.

MUSIC: Focusing on the beat in music and on long/short sounds, we will be looking at how the group 'Stomp' create beats using recycled objects.



HISTORY: N/A (Geography topic)

GEOGRAPHY: Using maps of the world, we will be learning about the equator and where the hot and cold countries are in relation to this. We will be looking at the human and physical features of the UK to help us decide which of the 4 countries in the UK we like best.

SCIENCE: Children will be finding out about living and non-living things. They will also be describing habitats and talking about how animals are suited to their environment. Finally we will be making simple food chains. Children in Y1 will be learning about the special features, types and parts of animals.

PE: During indoor PE will be doing Gymnastics and learning how to travel, roll and jump in different ways both on the floor and on the equipment. In outdoor PE we will be dribbling, kicking and hitting balls and making up games.

We will watch 'The Lorax' and look at pictures of pollution and environmental damage, discussing how this makes us feel.



VISITS/EVENTS
