

**ART:** In Art we will be using weaving to create a pattern for our Magic Carpets. Children will learn the primary and secondary colours to use in their Rangoli designs. They will be using rolled up paper to create an African animal mask which they will add texture to. Finally they will be using salt dough to create an African animal that they will carve a design onto.

**D&T:** In D&T we will be measuring and cutting fabric to create a magic carpet joined together by glue. The children will design and make their own African Moving Animal using a hinge or lever.

**MUSIC:** Taking inspiration from our African drumming lesson, I will learn to clap the rhythm to this style of music and take part in call and response music. I will listen out for different types of sounds in these different music styles



**PE:** Indoor - The class will be learning about the importance of living a healthy life style. Then they will be learning dances from around the world such as Banghra dancing. Outdoor - The children will be carrying out different balancing and gross motor skills such as ball skills and batting skills, as well as practising for Sports Day.



**RE-** We will learning about how Christians talk to God and the reasons they speak to God. The children will also learn about the Lord's Prayer. Finally they will be discussing and learning how they can make a difference in the world.

### CHARACTER EDUCATION

Me and Other People (mutual respect) - We will be Looking at what groups/communities we belong to, and we will also be learning strategies on how to deal with teasing.

Happy and Healthy Me (individual liberty) - We will be learning about the differences in needs as we grow older. We will also be identifying What constitutes a healthy lifestyle.



**HISTORY:** Magic Carpet is a Geography based topic so we won't be covering History this term.

**GEOGRAPHY:** Children will learn and be expected to know the continents and oceans of our world and where the UK is on a world map. We will also be learning about the Geographical similarities and differences between where we live and Africa/India.

**SCIENCE:** We will learn about and name a variety of garden plants and be able to know the difference between evergreen and deciduous trees. We will be able to observe the changes in the different seasons and the different weather which occurs also.

**CHALLENGE**

**ENGLISH:**  
We will be looking at narratives from other countries and cultures such as Handa's Surprise and The Tiger Child. We will be finding out information and writing non-chronological reports on African and Indian animals. We will also be creating poems and rhymes about African/Indian animals and other countries. We will also be focussing on improving our handwriting ready for Year 2!

**MATHS:** We will be revisiting all calculation methods, with a focus on multiplication and division. Also, we will be looking at the place value of 2-digit numbers and using this to quickly add and subtract 10/11. Finally, we will be looking at positional language.

**COMPUTING:** In computing we will be looking at programming, how to programme a beebot to move around the floor and screen and how to fix errors in programming. We will be moving onto using programming software to plan a sequence of commands.
