

ART: In Art we will be using weaving to create a pattern for our Magic Carpets. Children will learn the primary and secondary colours to use in their rangoli designs. They will be using rolled up paper to create an African animal mask which they will add texture to. Finally they will be using clay to create an African animal that they will carve a design onto.



D&T: In D&T we will be measuring and cutting fabric to create a magic carpet joined together by glue. The children will design and make their own safari buggy from wood. They will measure the wood and saw it themselves before gluing the pieces together to make a frame.



MUSIC: Taking inspiration from our African drumming lesson, We will be creating short rhythmic phrases and musical patterns. The children will also need to identify changes in pitch and duration.



PE: Indoor - The class will be learning About the importance of living a healthy Life style. Then they will be learning dances from around the world such as Banghra dancing. Outdoor - The children will be developing their own games using attackers and defenders and carrying out athletics events.



RE- We will learning about how Christians talk to God and the reasons they speak to God. The children will also learn about the Lord's Prayer. Finally they will be discussing and learning how they can make a difference in the world.

CHARACTER EDUCATION

Me and Other People (mutual respect) - We will be discussing differences and similarities between people. We will also look at who does the jobs and whether you have to be a man to be a police officer/fireman etc.
Happy and Healthy Me (individual liberty) - We will be Learning the importance of hygiene and how to live a healthy life.



HISTORY: Magic Carpet is a Geography based topic so we won't Be covering History this term.

GEOGRAPHY: Children will learn and be expected to know the continents and oceans of our world and where the UK is on a world map. We will also be learning about the Geographical similarities and differences between where we live and Africa/India.

SCIENCE: The children will need to know what conditions plants grow best in and what life processes are common to plants and animals. They will also learn about food chains and how to construct a food chain. After half term we will learn about John McAdam, John Dunlop and Charles Macintosh and their discoveries.

CHALLENGE

ENGLISH: We will create character profiles and stories using the Horrid Henry books.

We will be reading a range of texts from other countries and cultures such as the Leopard's Drum and Lila and the Secret of the Rain.

We will be finding out information and writing non-chronological reports on African and Indian animals, focusing on meerkats through the use of the book 'Meerkat Mail.'

MATHS: We will be revisiting all calculation methods. In our telling the time work we will look at feeding times at the safari. When learning about measures (capacity, length and weight) we will be relating maths to African animals.

COMPUTING: In computing we will be looking at programming an dhow to programme a roamer to move around the floor and screen. We will be moving onto using programming software to plan a sequence of commands.
