

ART: We will be drawing pictures of Florence's lamp and Superheroes using tones and texture with pencil crayons. We will also be creating a collage of a lighthouse scene.



D&T: We will be creating a lighthouse model with a working light bulb (Y2). All children will also create a moving superhero picture and prepare a sandwich of their choice for Mr Grinling using the correct equipment/hygiene routines.



MUSIC: In Music we will be creating superhero themed compositions and storm music using percussion instruments to make sounds of a storm. We will use the terms pitch, timbre and tempo. At Christmas we will be singing in tune and keeping to a rhythm.



HISTORY: We will be finding out about heroes from the past such as Florence Nightingale and Grace Darling. When doing this we will be creating timelines, describing historical events and using artefacts to find out about the past.



GEOGRAPHY: All good superheroes need to know their way around! We will be learning about the countries of the UK and their capital cities. We will also learn the names of the seas around the UK. Finally we find out about the patron Saint of each country within the UK.



SCIENCE: In Science we will covering two units, the uses of materials and then changing shapes of materials. When working with materials we will be sorting and classifying these and discussing the uses of different materials. In our changing shape unit, we will find out how the shapes of some materials can be changed.



PE:

Children will begin PE with Gymnastics for their indoor lesson and throwing and Catching skills for their outdoor PE.



After half term we will move onto Dance for indoor PE and kicking and hitting ball skills in outdoor PE.

RE: In our RE lessons we will be looking at creation and how the world was created. We will also be learning about incarnation and the importance of Christmas to Christians. As part of this unit the children will be learning about the advent wreath and how to prepare for a new baby.

CHARACTER EDUCATION:

We will start by discussing the importance of rules and why we have rules for children and adults. We will then create our own set of class rules. We will also discuss the rule of the law and how this helps us. In our lessons we will discuss the role of a school councillor and elect our class representatives. Finally we will discuss our feelings and how to deal with feelings such as anger and sadness.

Children will dress up as a superhero and carry out superhero tasks e.g. free a captured superhero from the ice.


VISITS/EVENTS

Creating a model of a lighthouse

ENGLISH: In English we will cover a range of genres such as fiction, non-fiction and poetry. In our non-fiction work we will be finding out about the lives of Florence Nightingale and Grace Darling. In fiction work we will be using the following books:



MATHS: In Maths we will be developing our understanding of number and place value by partitioning numbers in tens and ones. We will also learn how to carry addition, subtraction, multiplication and division and then deepen our understanding of these areas using superhero related problems.

Throughout the term we will also learn to tell the time to the nearest 15 minutes and learn how to make amounts using money.

COMPUTING: At the start of the year we will be watching Hector's World and discussing how to use computers safely. We will then be using MS word to learn typing skills. After half term we will use the internet to carry out research on our topic.
