



## Pupil Voice Meeting - Play Leaders

<b>1</b>	Present	Chair: Mr Dobberson (Assistant Head); Maisie Barber, Rubie Comley, Isaac Howe-Jones, Ashleigh Hodges, Tallula Hunt
<b>2</b>	Prayer	Read.
<b>3</b>	Feedback from Play Leaders-in-Charge	<p>The Play Leaders-in-Charge reported that things were going well, although there were some concerns about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• An increasingly reckless attitude to equipment by some pupils, resulting in breakages. This was particularly so with hoops and skipping ropes, which were not always being used appropriately. Mr Dobberson said that he would address this in an assembly.</li> <li>• New balls for KS2 were needed, and Mr Dobberson noted that he was already looking to purchase some over-sized tennis balls.</li> <li>• Play Leaders-in-Charge felt that some of the Play Leaders weren't doing their jobs properly. Mr Dobberson commented that having observed Play Leaders at work in recent weeks, there were some who were playing alongside children, rather than helping them to play. However, he had greater concerns with a few of the Play Leaders who were completely inactive.</li> </ul>
<b>5</b>	Playing with children	Mr Dobberson asked the Play Leaders-in-Charge whether it would be useful for Play Leaders to have some further training now that they were doing the job. They thought this was an excellent idea, and Mr Dobberson agreed to find a slot after the Christmas break in which he would go through how to use the equipment, and how to become more involved in helping other children to play.
<b>6</b>	Putting away equipment	Mr Dobberson noted that equipment was often being left out at the end of lunch break, particularly on the KS1 playground, and reminded the Play Leaders-in-Charge that one of their duties required them to check that no equipment was left out at the end of lunch break.
<b>7</b>	Commitment	Mr Dobberson thanked the Play Leaders-in-Charge (and Play Leaders) for their commitment, noting that he had no knowledge of any of the 31 Play Leaders failing to turn up for their duties. He asked the Play Leaders-in-Charge to thank the Play Leaders for him (although he would try to thank them personally).
<b>8</b>	Health & Safety	No health and safety issues arose.
