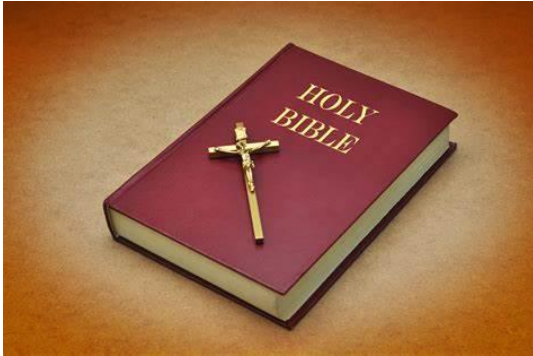




Christian Artefacts



The Bible - The Christian Holy Book is called the Bible. It is made up of two sections.

The Old Testament - This is the first part of the Bible which was complete before Jesus was born. Jews refer to it as the Tanakh.

The New Testament - This is the second part of the Bible and contains the books that were written after Jesus Christ was born.



Baptismal Candle - A candle is often given to the parents when a child is baptised. It symbolises welcome and that the child has passed from the darkness into the light.

Christian Artefacts

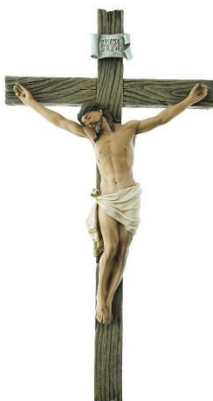


Chalice - A large cup that is used in the Christian Eucharist.

Paten - A special plate, typically made from gold or silver, that is used to hold the bread during the Eucharist and sometimes as a cover for the Chalice.



Rosary Beads - Rosary Beads are a physical way of keeping count of the Hail Marys said. The fingers are moved along the beads as the prayers are recited.



Crucifix - The Crucifix is a representation of the cross with a figure of Christ on it. It helps Christians to remember the sacrifice that Jesus made.
