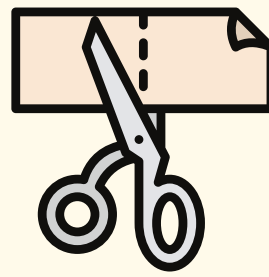
What do I already know how to do?

Accurately



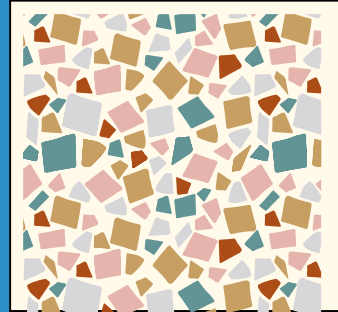
cutting accurately means cutting something in just the right way, following a line, shape, or measurement carefully.

Form



refers to the 3D quality or appearance of an object.

Mosaic



a picture or design made by putting together small pieces of colourful materials like glass, stone, or tiles.

Pattern



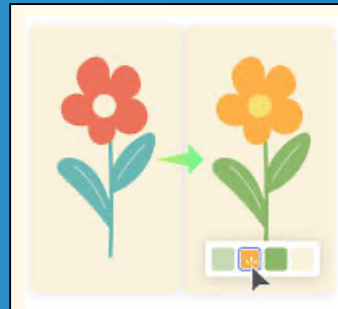
something that repeats. It can be shapes, colours, or designs that happen over and over in a predictable order.

Precision



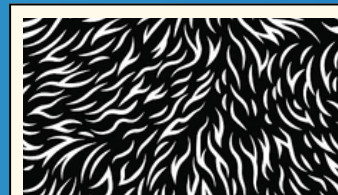
precision means doing something very carefully and exactly, without any mistakes.

Refine



means to make a piece of art better by adding details, fixing mistakes, or improving how it looks.

Texture



the feel or look of a surface.

Emma Biggs

Emma Biggs (born 1956) is a London-based mosaic artist who loves to make beautiful pictures and patterns using tiny pieces of coloured glass, stone, or tiles. This kind of art is called mosaics.

Emma completed a large public art project, "Made in England", based on the visual culture of the pottery industry in Stoke-on-Trent. She set up the influential company Mosaic Workshop in 1987, which went on to be the UK's most thriving mosaic studio.

Emma also teaches people about art and writes books to share her ideas. She is known for being very creative and for making amazing artwork that inspires people all over the world!
